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The New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services has funded this program.

Tech companies are introducing ways to integrate consumers' information into their smartphone. We plan to leverage this pilot project to increase the adoption of smart phone-based viewers that would enable patients to view and share their clinical data.

Why participate?

- Utilizing this service, New Jersey should anticipate increased adoption of the smart phone-based viewers.
- The ease of patients accessing their clinical data in one location will act as a catalyst to patient adoption.

Who is eligible?

 Any Medicaid providers that are currently submitting CCD documents to the New Jersey Health Information Network (NJHIN) are eligible.

What can NJII do for participants?

NJII will collect all the CCD documents from contributing providers for each patient.

These will be made available to each patient rather than forcing them to log into each providers portal to access each patient's clinical data.
